




eMail Scam Alert

If you receive an email with the subject line " Signature requested by National Association of REALTORS®," it is NOT from NAR. The email spoofs a Citrix ShareFile site and asks you to sign an "important file" from NAR.

If you receive this fraudulent email, alert NAR Member Support at ContactNAR@realtors.org and then delete the email.

Tips to guard against phishing scams such as this one:

- Be wary of emails that ask you to view or download files from people you do not know.
- Also be cautious of emails that ask you to view files on services that you do not subscribe to.
- Hover your mouse over the URL (do not click) of links contained in emails to check their destination address. To log into a service like Dropbox or Google Drive, open a new web browser and type in the URL manually.
- Be wary of services that ask you to provide log-in credentials for a number of different email providers. This is a trick scammers use to widen their phishing net, allowing them to steal details from users.
