SEDONA SIGN CODE PROPOSAL

The Sedona city council has begun review of the Sedona sign code after receiving a 4-2 vote recommendation from the Planning & Zoning Commission and fully supported by city staff to ban **ALL** temporary off-site signs.

This would include Open House signs, garage/estate sale signs, SEE's candy, blood drives, Open Studio, 'Wedding' directional, etc. . . . the WORKS!

Basically, with a U.S. Supreme Court ruling on a Gilbert, Arizona city sign case, a city must treat ALL signs the same with no special rules for some kinds of signs (there CAN be rules on size, time limits, construction material, etc. but not 'content' of what's on the sign).

Sedona city staff has come up with the proposal that instead of dealing with problems which these signs *might* involve, just ban ALL temporary signs. **This would be enormously damaging to our business** and we oppose this plan completely as it stands.
