Before 2016, the National Association of REALTORS® required all its members to take a Code of Ethics course every four years, which is why it was formerly known as the NAR Quadrennial Requirement. This year, however, the Quadrennial requirement becomes a Biennial requirement, meaning that each REALTOR® must now take a Code of Ethics course every two years. REALTORS® have until the end of 2018 (12/31/18) to complete their coursework for this cycle.
